The institution is located at Cubbonpet on the very spot where once existed the little chapel dedicated to Our Lady of Lourdes. It was in the year 1947 that the school started functioning. Later on, the little chapel was shifted to a new place in J.C. Road where the present church stands dedicated to St. Theresa. As the number of students increased, the building was gradually developed by Rev. Fr. John Castelino, and then by his successor Rev. Fr. I. Anthappa who was also responsible for upgrading the school to the level of High School for both Boys and Girls. The other Managers also contributed significantly for upgrading the Institution.

SCHOOL RULES/GUIDELINES (for Students)

General

- Students must maintain a high standard of discipline at all times. Use of foul or abusive language is considered to be a serious offence.
- The name, class and section of the pupil should be neatly marked on all belongings of the pupil.
- Class rooms and lockers must be kept clean at all times. Desks and book shelves must be kept tidy. Desks, textbooks and exercise books must not be defaced in any way.
- Any unclaimed article(s) found on the campus must be deposited with the "lost & found" in-charge staff.
- Students are not permitted to wear expensive watches / jewellery. The school will not be responsible for the loss of personal property brought to the school by students. Students will not bring or carry valuable articles such as video games, cell phones etc., to school. The item will be confiscated and shall not be returned. Besides, disciplinary action will be taken against the student.
- Any damage to the class / school property must be immediately reported to the class teacher / school authorities.
- Vandalizing school property, throwing stones / sand / anything solid, or indulging in colour throwing, or bursting crackers is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- Students should adhere strictly to the rules and regulations of the school, failing which, they are liable for disciplinary action.

Note :- The child should be in the school 10 minutes before the 1st bell. Otherwise he/she will be sent home.

Students must always put on the correct uniform / dress as specified for the day / occasion / event. The specified school dress should be worn on specified day(s). Students should be neatly dressed. Shirts should be neatly tucked into trousers / skirts & school belt must be clearly visible. Low waist skirts and trousers are strictly prohibited. Socks must be at least six inches above the ankle. Shoes must be polished every day.

No colouring of hair is allowed. The students will be sent home if hair is coloured. Girls should plait their hair, and should be below the shoulders. Short hair should be neatly pinned. Long pony tail or open hair is not allowed. Boys should get their hair cut at regular intervals.

- Students are expected to respect the property of others. This includes respect for School Property. No student should damage any school furniture, write or draw anything on the walls / furniture or in any way damage things belonging to others. Damage done even by accident should be reported at once to the Class Teacher. Any damage done (with suitable fine) will be made good by the one who causes it. Students should be polite wherever they go. They should always remember that the school is judged by their conduct.
- No student shall indulge in any of the following practices:
 - a) Spitting in or near the School building
 - b) Disfiguring or damaging the School property
 - c) Rude behaviour

d) Use of violence in any form

The School reserves the right to suspend /expel the student, when progress in studies or conduct / discipline is found to be unsatisfactory.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

SCHOOL RULES / GUIDELINES (for Parents / Guardians)

Circular's/Messages from the School : Parents are requested to read carefully all the circulars & messages, issued from the school time to time, and take suitable action (s).

Fee Payment : Parents are requested to kindly adhere to the fee payment schedule. NO REMINDERS will be issued from the school. Fee once paid, will not be refunded / adjusted.

Meeting during class hours : Parents are discouraged from meeting the teachers or their wards during the class hours. Also, they are requested not to walk in the corridors, when the school is functioning. Parents/Guardians cannot visit their wards or meet teachers in the class rooms.

Meeting with Teachers / their ward(s) : Parents desirous of meeting the Class / Subject Teacher (s) can do so only on the PTM day or as per communication(s) sent from the school.

Late coming to the School : For students coming late to the school, the school gate will be closed.

Transfer Certificate (TC) : TC will be issued once all dues have been cleared. One week notice in writing should be given to the school for getting the TC. If the notice is received when the academic session (April 2024) starts, term fees has to be paid.

Parent Teacher Meeting (PTM) : PTM will be conducted as per the academic calendar. It is strongly desired that parents attend the PTM (s). They, then should go through the personal file the progress report of their ward, and endorse their remarks / comments.

Interference in School Administration : If a parent is found interfering directly or indirectly in the School administration, the School reserves the right to remove the name of their ward from the rolls of the School.

School Discipline : Once students enter the School premises, they cannot leave without the explicit written permission of the Head Mistress. Once a child has come to School, he / she should not be asked to come home on half day leave or leave from any period unless there is grave emergency; in which case, permission should be taken from the Head Mistress. Outstation trips should be strictly avoided on working days. Parents are requested not to fix medical appointments or any kind of social engagements during the school working hours.
